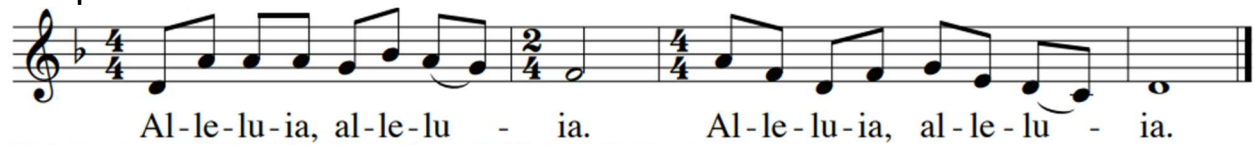
Second Reading

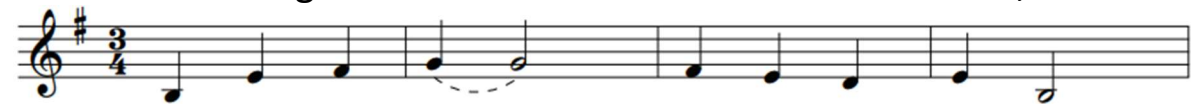

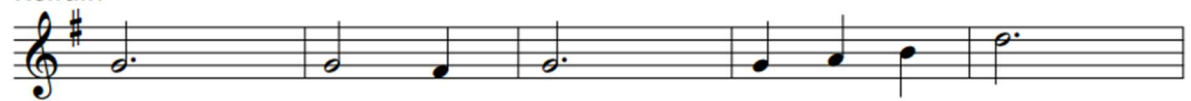

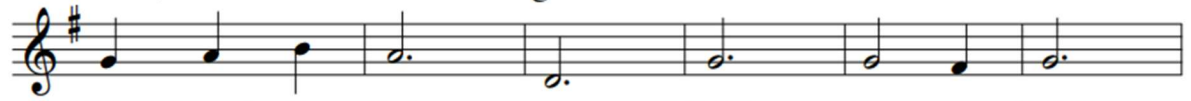
